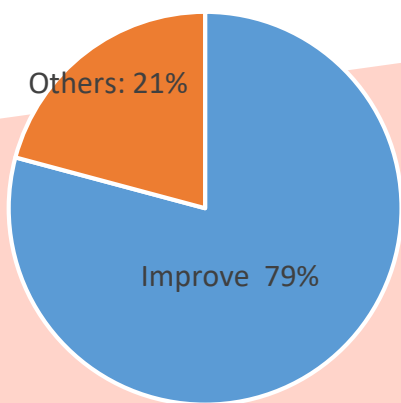

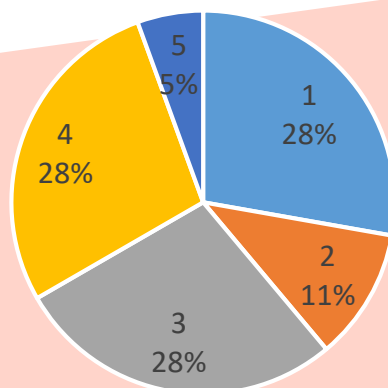
- 16 questions pre and post-test with clinical photos.
